

Draft Report on New Membership of PMNCH January-March 2015

This report aims to update PMNCH management and the Executive Committee on the status of PMNCH new membership. The document provides an overview of the results of the membership process, which was carried out during the first quarter of 2015, outlining new members, their constituencies, priority areas and countries/ regions. Please see Annex 1 for new members details and Annex 2 for graph representation of the new membership.

Overview

Currently PMNCH has a total of 681 member organizations from different parts of the world, divided among seven constituencies as follows:

During the first quarter of 2015, PMNCH Secretariat received a total of 54 membership applications. A review process took place, including seeking WHO due diligence when required, e.g. in the case of the Private Sector applicants. A total of 39 memberships have been approved.

There are 15 applications put on hold, either due to missing necessary information or being reviewed by WHO relevant departments. Feedback on those applications will be included in the report of the second quarter of 2015.

Priority areas and geographic distribution

New members have been assigned to relevant constituencies, but the majority pertain to the NGOs constituency.

While the Secretariat receives applications from different regions, during this quarter new members are mostly from Africa and then from the Americas. There are different purposes and priority areas for applicants seeking PMNCH membership. The following are the five main areas of interest among new members, listed in priority order:

- Sexual and reproductive health;
- Maternal and child health;
- Newborn health;
- Education; and
- Youth and adolescent health.

Other priority areas that were mentioned, however not with the same frequency as the above, are: human rights, nutrition, water and sanitation, climate change and environmental health, family planning and preventing child marriage.
