Context for the consultation

Undertaken in the context of updating the **Global Strategy** for Women's, Children's and Adolescents' Health and under the **Every Woman Every Child banner**.

Objective of consultation to canvass and **synthesize views** from members and the wider RMNCAH community on the GFF proposed modalities.

Report from PMNCH to be presented to the **GFF Oversight Group** in **mid- December 2014**.

Broader consultations from **early-2015** to support the process of updating the Global Strategy for Women's, Children's and Adolescents' Health



Demographic data from the online survey






Emerging headlines around the Global Strategy





The GFF is seen as an **opportunity** to build long-term domestic financing for RMNCAH






And a good chance to work at the **interface of sectors** on challenging problems
