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# Proposed PMNCH 2015 Areas of Work

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# Introduction and context

- PMNCH enters the 2015 transition year having achieved much and with a number of important ongoing workstreams
- In line with existing Strategic Framework, nine ongoing areas of work are proposed for PMNCH 2015 workplan, which take account of:
  - major current or expected developments in the RMNCAH space
  - achievements in the 2014 and previous years
  - findings from the external evaluation of PMNCH
- All areas of work aim to maximize PMNCH impact on MDGs, whilst creating the foundation for continued impact in 2016 and beyond

1	<b>Supporting advocacy efforts related to Every Woman Every Child</b>
2	<b>Developing the PMNCH Strategic Framework for 2016 and beyond</b>
3	<b>Advocating for an agreed PMNCH position on women's, children's and adolescent's health within the context of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)</b>

## Proposed areas of work (cont.)

#	Description
4	<b>Contributing to the update of the Global Strategy for Women's, Children's, and Adolescent's Health</b>
5	<b>Engaging in the work on RMNCAH financing</b> , including the consultations on the Global Financing Facility (GFF), as part of the eventual implementation mechanisms for the updated Global Strategy
6	<b>Supporting the country multi-stakeholder dialogue (MSD) and/ or consultations</b> , linked to the update of the Global Strategy process

## Proposed areas of work (cont.)

#	Description
7	<b>Promoting accountability and human rights</b> , linked to the update of the Global Strategy process
8	<b>Hosting the Countdown to 2015</b> (e.g. hosting the initiative and its secretariat, and supporting activities within the Countdown to 2015 workplan, such as advocacy and communications, etc.)
9	<b>Strengthening partnership operations and core functions</b> , including managing PMNCH governance and constituencies, corporate communications, administration and management

# Initial budget estimate and sense of emphasis

Proposed areas of work budget	US\$ 10 million
Supporting advocacy efforts related to Every Woman Every Child	2%
Developing the PMNCH Strategic Framework for 2016 and beyond , including governance review	6%
Advocating for an agreed PMNCH position on women's, children's and adolescent's health within the context of SDGs	7%
Contributing to the update of the Global Strategy for Women's, Children's, and Adolescent's Health	20%
Engaging in the work on RMNCAH financing, including GFF	6%
Supporting the country multi-stakeholder dialogue and/ or consultations	16%
Promoting accountability and human rights, linked to the update of the Global Strategy process	12%
Hosting and supporting the Countdown to 2015	15%
Partnership strengthening and core functions	16%
