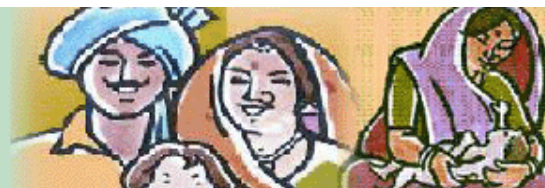

The Context

- **29 Million pregnancies in a year**
 - **26 Million deliveries**
 - **15% likely to develop complications**
 - **Over 57 thousand maternal deaths**
 - **Over 9 hundred thousand neonatal deaths**



Paradigm Shift

- **Policy commitment**
- **Entitlements based approach**
- **Elimination of out of pocket expenses**
- **Service guarantee through accountability**



What would the scheme do?

- Reduce barriers to access
- Benefit over 12 million women and new-borns who access government health facilities every year
- Bring 7 million women delivering at home to facilities
- Motivate 7 million women going to private facilities to deliver in government facilities



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Entitlements for pregnant women

- Free and cashless delivery including C-Section

- ❖ Free drugs and consumables
- ❖ Free diagnostics
- ❖ Free provision of blood

- Free diet during stay in health institutions

- ❖ Up to 3 days for normal delivery
- ❖ 7 days for Caesarean sections

- Free transport

- ❖ Home to health institution
- ❖ Between health institutions in case of referral
- ❖ Drop back home after delivery

- Exemption from all kinds of user charges, including for seeking hospital care up to 6 weeks post delivery (for post natal complications)



Entitlements for sick neonates (30 days after birth)

- **Free treatment at the public health institutions**
 - ❖ Free drugs and consumables
 - ❖ Free diagnostics
 - ❖ Free provision of blood
- **Free transport**
 - ❖ Home to health institution
 - ❖ Between health institutions in case of referral
 - ❖ Drop back home after delivery
- **Exemption from all kinds of user charges**

For Pregnant Women & Newborns

Entitlements for Pregnant Women:

- » Free delivery
- » Free caesarean section
- » Free drugs and consumables
- » Free diagnostics (Blood, Urine tests and Ultrasonography etc.)
- » Free diet during stay (upto 3days for normal delivery and 7days for caesarean section)
- » Free provision of blood
- » Free transport from home to health institution, between health institutions in case of referrals and drop back home
- » Exemption from all kinds of user charges

Entitlements for Sick Newborn till 30 days after birth:

- » Free and zero expense treatment
- » Free drugs & consumables
- » Free diagnostics
- » Free provision of blood
- » Free transport from home to health institution, between health institutions in case of referrals and drop back home
- » Exemption from all kinds of user charges

281 million USD allocated toward provision of entitlements out of an annual NRHM budget of 3.5 billion USD

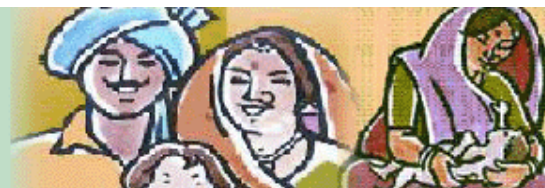
