# 19:00-21:00 Reception for the H4+ Commitment to The Global Strategy For Women's And Children's Health and the launch Of Born Too Soon: The Global Action Report For Preterm Birth

The H4+ (UN agencies working on Maternal and Newborn Health: UNAIDS, UNFPA, UNICEF, WHO, the World Bank and UN Women) provides harmonized support to countries with high rates of maternal, newborn and child mortality, to accelerate progress in achieving MDGs 4 and 5 by 2015, and to fulfill their commitments in line with the Global Strategy for Women's and Children's Health.

The UN Deputy Secretary General will launch *Born Too Soon: The Global Action Report for Preterm Birth.* This report (which includes a foreword by the UN Secretary-General) is the first-ever global report on preterm births outlines urgent policy, program and research actions to improve prevention of preterm birth.
