## Functioning of accounts and audit

 PMNCH is hosted by WHO – it is not a separate legal entity

 All funds allocated to PMNCH are channeled through WHO and into a fully ring-fenced PMNCH account

•FC (as sub-committee of the Board) reviews PMNCH funding flows in relation to the Workplan and reports to the Board on a regular basis

## Income & resource mobilisation for 2012 & beyond

- On 3 Feb DFID, CIDA, and Sida co-hosted a successful meeting in London on engaging/ delivering PMNCH 2012–15 workplan
- Donors reaffirmed their strong support for the Partnership and called on each other to fund PMNCH workplan
- Currently over 60% of 2012 budget is funded (US\$ 8.89m)
- 59% of pledged funding is provided as unspecified grants
- Multiyear grants were received from several donors



## Income & resource mobilisation for 2012 & beyond

- US\$ 5.38m is still to be raised from a total of US\$ 14.27m and prospects are relatively good
- Ongoing applications and discussions with:
  - Governments of France, Germany, Japan, Netherlands, Norway, Sweden, USA
  - Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation
  - Private sector (any funding from private sector will be subject to normal WHO due diligence regulations)
- Support from Board and Partners will be welcomed in pursuing these and new funding opportunities
