What we do

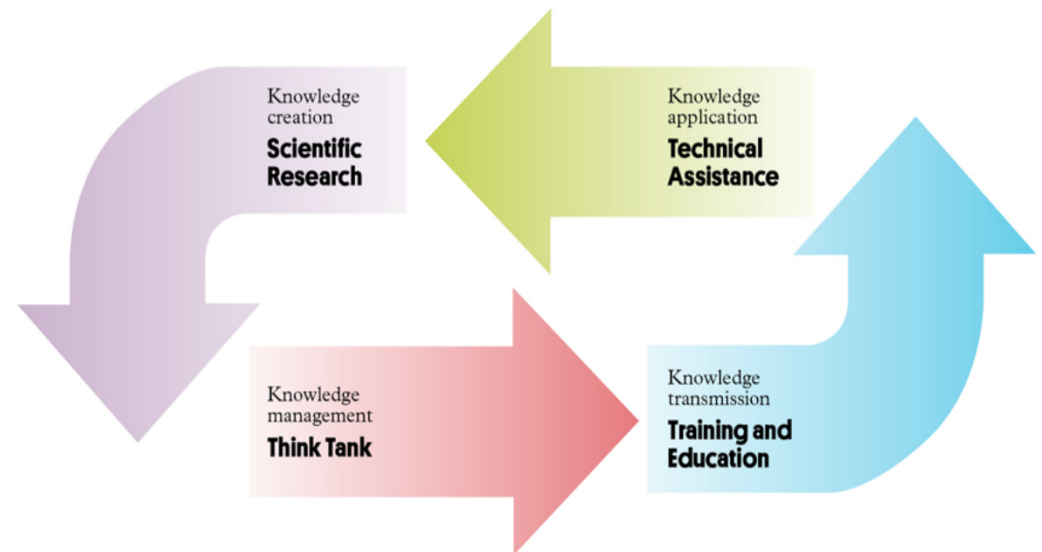


The **Barcelona Institute for Global** tackles health problems affecting the world's most vulnerable populations through the creation, sharing and application of knowledge
