PMNCH Board Meeting Dec 2 - 3, 2007, Addis

Working Group on Advocacy Chairs: Arletty Pinel, Doyin Oluwole

- Commissioned Options report, first comprehensive mapping of stakeholder knowledge and attitudes related to MNCH in six countries (developed and developing)
- Global launch of *Deliver Now* advocacy drive
- MNCH campaign plans developed for India and Tanzania through local NGOs
- Developed 2008 value-added work plan for global, regional and country political advocacy



Working Group on Country Support Chairs: Al Bartlett, Nancy Terreri

- Finalized, disseminated the document "Operationalizing the Partnership's Approach to Country Support"
- Supported the establishment of Tanzania's PMNCH and the development of one plan for MNCH
- Supported the launch of Nigeria's PMNCH; high-level advocacy with key decision makers which lead to the allocation of funds from debt relief to MDGs 4 and 5
- Supported Ethiopia's Health System Development review meeting
- Supported the elaboration of a proposal for support under the PMNCH Grant in Ethiopia and Nigeria
- Elaborated a proposal for the establishment of an NGO constituency coordination mechanism in Nigeria (White Ribbon Alliance)

- Mapping of evidence of essential MNCH interventions, packages and delivery strategies underway
