 - innovative/ bold (to capture the imagination of the executive leadership of partners in working together); and
 - deliverable in a reasonable time frame (say 3-5 years maximum).



Advocacy

Use existing and new information to proactively influence stakeholders external to the partnership

Learning, Knowledge Sharing & Monitoring

Gathering/ sharing information; and monitoring MNCH programs and projects to ensure partner accountability

Harmonisation

Harmonise MNCH approaches, tools and processes to improve effectiveness of MNCH policies, programs and investments

Facilitation, Coordination and Brokerage Bring together MNCH stakeholders to achieve common objectives, and thereby foster new and innovative 'partnering' approaches to reach MNCH outcomes
