Overview


- PMNCH's mission: Achieve MDG 4 & 5

 - 1. Raise \$30 billion
 - 2. Promote evidence based, high impact interventions and means to delver them
 - 3. Hold responsible parties to account and measure progress
- To be accomplished by implementing 7
 priority actions over 3 years (year one actions
 outlined in most detail in work plan)

Overview

- This draft workplan represents the work of multiple partners and the secretariat
- It attempts to:
 - apply principles outlined during last board meeting
 - focus down on a few important and compelling actions
 - capture work to be done by partners and secretariat
- It represents an implicit impact model through which PMNCH can contribute to achieving MDGs 4 & 5.
- It is a work in progress

7 Priority actions

- 2. Develop costed national strategies
- Identify gaps in delivery of MNCH core package of interventions and prioritize implementation research

- Suggests appropriate priority actions which are interrelated (implying an implicit theory of change) and synergistic.
- Clearly outlines the partnership's value added
- Provides clear roles for partners and the secretariat
- Provides a clear rationale for resources as well as potential sources for those resources
- Takes us beyond planning to action

It's not perfect, but...

- Is it good enough to give us confidence?
- Is it good enough to move forward?
- Is it good enough to allow us to start to work in partnership this year to achieve the intermediate outcomes?

Options for way forward

- Approve it as is and ask that the task teams refine the work on a timeline - but let's get to work.
- Approve one or more of the priority action work plans, let's begin work on those as we refine the rest on a timeline.
- Work further on the work plan before deciding.
