


Overview of 2009

- A new Memorandum of Understanding signed with host agency (WHO) covering 2009 – 2011
- The Board met twice during 2009 in February and December
- Executive Committee met monthly to take decisions between Board meetings, especially on governance, work-plan and staffing matters, and provide Secretariat oversight
- Finance Committee met three times in 2009 to review financial position of PMNCH and advise the Secretariat on financial issues
- **Secretariat** is now fully staffed, recruitment having proceeded rapidly during the summer months with full support from WHO

Enhancing communication

- The Partnership's website is regularly updated transition to interaction with the knowledge portal foreseen for 2010

Improving management processes

- New internal accounting and financial monitoring systems that reflect the needs of the new operational model and the agreed PAs
- Ongoing staff evaluation and development processes implemented
