The Executive Committee - History and Mandate OVERVIEW

- Created following decision at Nov 2008 Board Meeting
- To allow (between Board Meetings):
 - Appropriate action and recommendations to the Board on governance issues
 - Review/amendment of workplan implementation
 - Oversight of Secretariat activities

MANDATE

- Advise the Board on core strategies
- Oversee and track resource mobilization
- Monitor overall performance and workplan implementation
- Monitor and advise the Board on core governance structures

Review implementation workplan

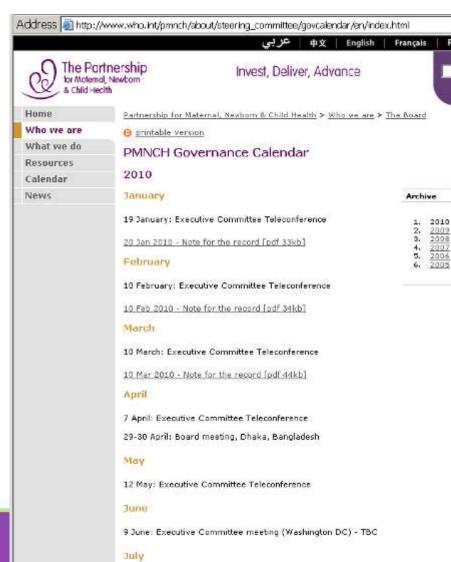
- I. Updates on PA5 and developments on the UN SG led Joint Initiative, PMNCH role
