
Countdown to 2030 for Women's, Children's and Adolescent's Health:

Results from 2025 Annual Meeting

For the past five years, the Countdown, in collaboration with partners, has held an annual multi-country workshop with sub-Saharan Africa countries. These workshops:

- Strengthen country-led progress and performance reviews,
- Inform annual health sector reviews, midterm and endline assessments of GFF investment cases; and
- Contribute to other country processes.

This year's workshop, which was held in June in Nairobi, involved included 34 countries. The objectives of the workshop were to equip country teams with skills to develop national and subnational estimates of key RMNCAH and nutrition indicators using all available country data including routine health facility, household survey, and population data. Each country team generated a full report explaining every step of the analysis and a short synthesis report that is publicly available.



Countdown is a global collaboration of academics, UN agencies, regional networks, country institutions and civil society organizations.
