






# The Partnership in the Global Strategy architecture

# **SO2: Drive Accountability**

#### Unified Accountability Framework

- Host Post-2015 Working Group, in consultations on Global Strategy Monitoring Framework
- Major consultation, November 2015, with WHO, to review lessons from CoIA and iERG
- March 2016 planning meeting, with WHO, EOSG, governments of Canada & Norway, to develop workplan; review roles and responsibilities
- Funding Citizens Hearings in Kenya,
   Mauritania, Sudan




